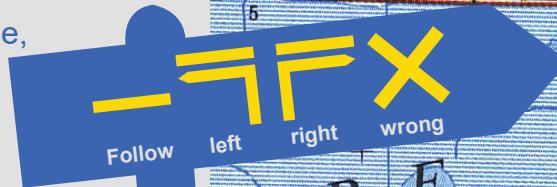

Three quarters at the edge of the water (the Seine, the Risle and the return channel), the mouth of the Risle flowing into the Seine, old fishing port with its old boats on display.

- 1 Beside the boat, facing the Seine, go right to follow the river upstream. After the lighthouse, leave the jetty to follow a dirt track that runs along the estuary of the Risle.
- 2 At the mouth of the Risle, continue to the right and go back to the port of Berville / mer by the return channel.
- 3 Exit of the marked circuit to discover the old port: cross the dam, then take immediately left to see the boat "Belle de Seine" and the landscape on the other side of the canal .
- 4 Retrace your path to find the descent of the port of Berville then cross the dam again to turn left and find the marked circuit at the edge of the canal.
- 5 At the end of the little grass path, turn right to join the Seine.



**Recommendations :** beware of high tides, part of this trail is likely to be flooded and difficult to practice at high tide, a few days in the year.

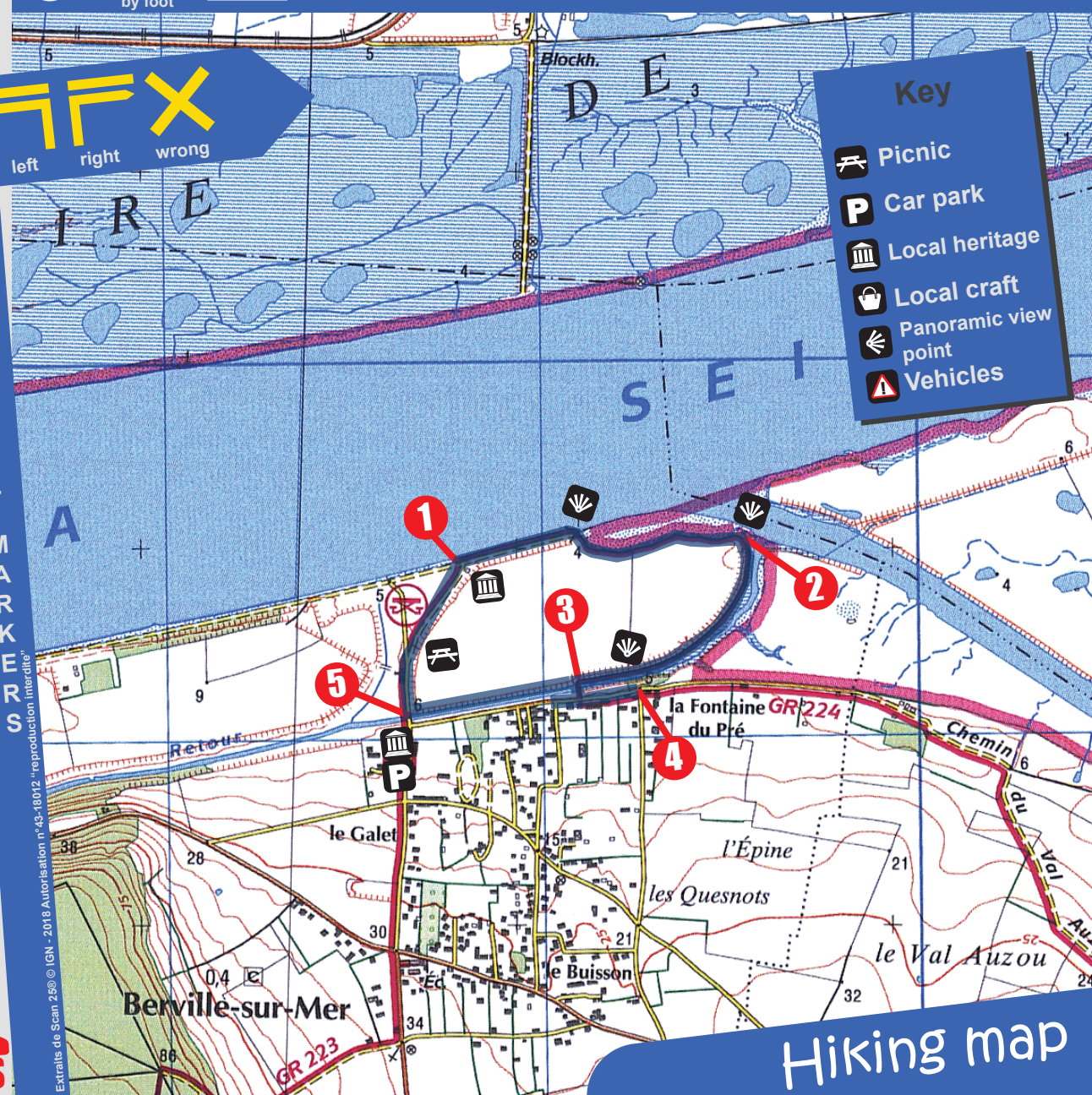
