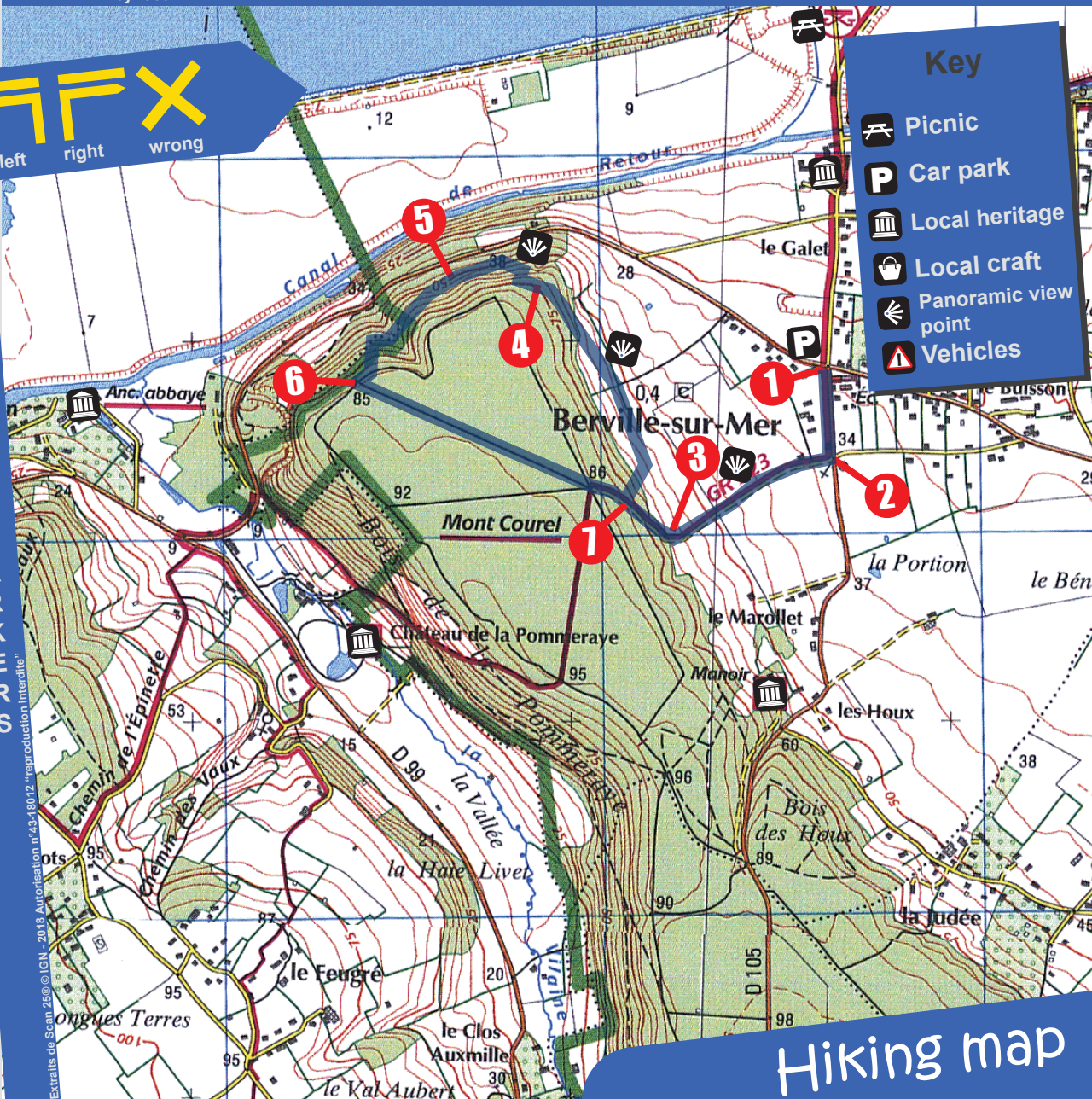

Mount Courel Communal Forest (Natural Area Sensitive of the department of Eure), heathland, rare plant formations in Normandy, panoramas on the estuary of the Seine, some trees of good size.

- 1 Facing the town hall, go right on the small road along the town hall and revealing its date of construction.
- 2 At the crossroads, turn right towards the Mount Courel forest, cross the barrier that prohibits the passage of motor vehicles (*this path is reserved for pedestrians*).
- 3 At the top, in the clearing, turn right and after 100 meters, turn right again.
- 4 Go down the stairs to discover the "ravine forest", with a cool and humid atmosphere, where the profiles drawn on a pedagogical panel teach us to identify the different ferns.
- 5 Follow the old hollow path that goes softly, revealing beautiful trees.
- 6 At the top, follow the path to the right and immediately turn left towards the straight alley that leads back to the heart of the forest, passing in front of a pond.
- 7 Back to the clearing, take the path back down to the town hall (and through which you climbed into the forest).



**Beware :** some Saturdays, the path is forbidden in autumn and winter during big-game hunting.
