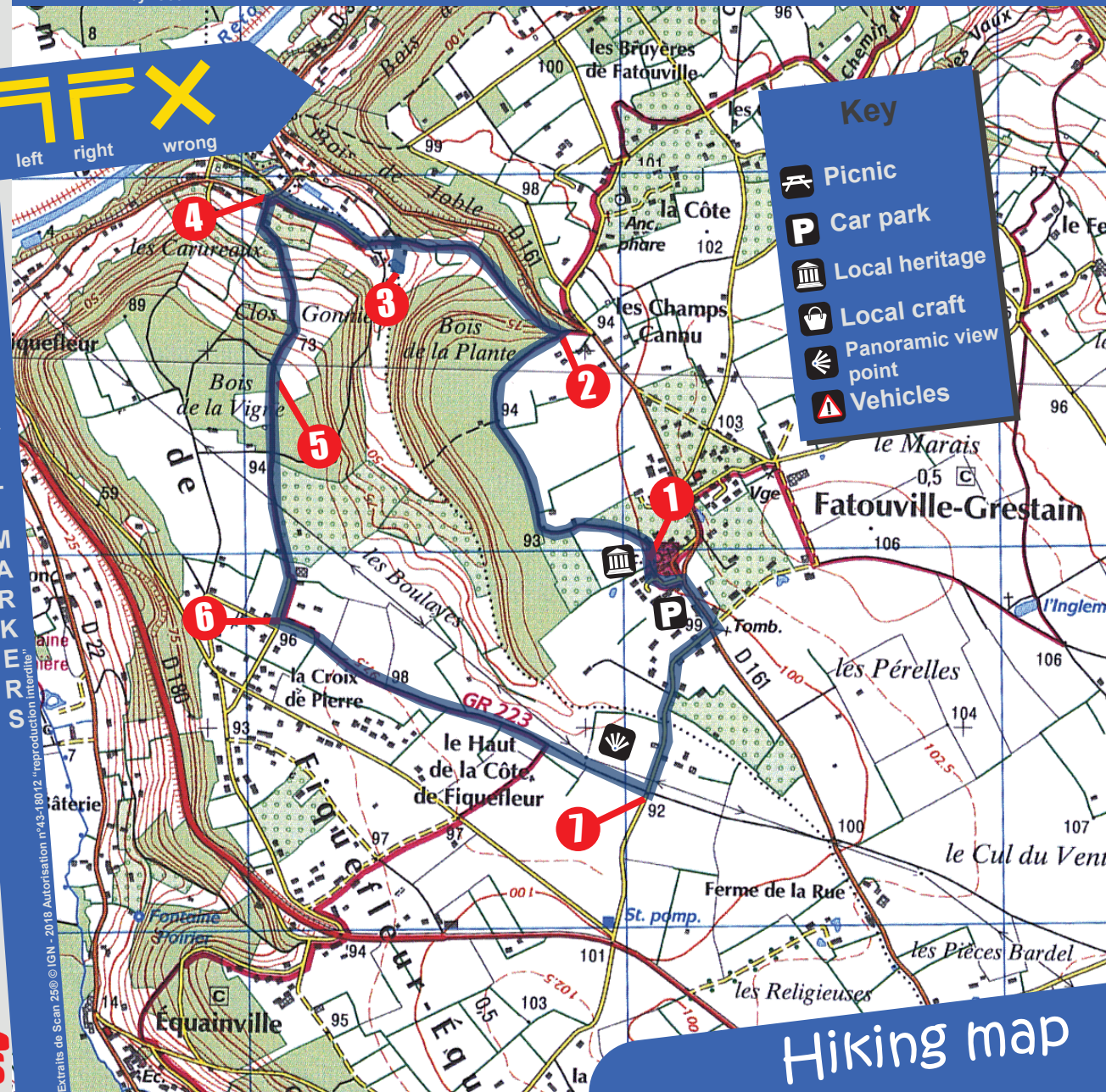
Stream and village of Jobles, views of the Normandy bridge and the estuary, bocage and forest.

Away from the trail: Abbey of Grestain founded in 1050 by Herluin, the foster father of William the conqueror.



- 1 Back to the church, go right towards the subdivision. At the end of the impasse, enter the path that goes around the cemetery before leaving between two embankments towards the forest ..
- 2 At the junction with the GR 223, turn left to go down to the valley. Next to the washhouse, go left for a round trip to the source.
- 3 After this refreshing break, continue down to the hamlet of Jobles.
- 4 At the bottom, arrived at the road that you do not cross, turn left to go immediately to the left by a beautiful hollow path.
- 5 Once up, in the woods, continue straight ahead ..
- 6 Reaching the tar, in the hamlet of the Croix de Pierre, turn left to find a path that crosses the countryside. Follow straight to leave the GR.
- 7 Back on the tar, take the small road on the left which brings you back to the village of Fatouville, passing the village hall.
