Away from the path : church with half-timbered porch, ancient yew & mill, fountain with wash-house near the town.

- Back to the church, go down to the village and go under the bridge of the National Road and in front of the shops.
- At the traffic lights, turn right along the town hall and the school by the Rue de la Forge. Go up the road always straight.
- At the top, after the clay trap and the green waste dump, turn right into the forest. At the exit of the wood, turn right on the small road.
- On the edge of the valley, turn left to stay on the heights always straight.
- Back on the road, turn left. At the first junction, turn right then left on the second.
- Follow the road of Val Loyer to the left then turn by the small path on the left. Continue straight back on the tar.
- At the junction, turn right onto the hollow path. At the fork, turn left to go down through the woods called la Brûlette.
- Once down, continue straight ahead along the valley. After the series of beautiful thatched cottages, take the road to the left, staying on the left side of the road.
- Take the small path on the left which brings you back above the town hall and then go down to the right towards the car park.
