

In Villerville

The narrow and coloured roads of Villerville lead you to the sea and two beaches: the Graves beach to the west and the East Beach. They are just accessible at low tide, but you can walk - when the tide is high - on the dyke dominating it and stretching along the Roches Noires steep cliffs. The Roches Noires cliffs, a delicate natural area, are 60 m high and owe their name to the blocks of limestone rock found on the beach.



The access from the centre of Villerville is hard by car, it's better to reach the beach on foot from the Rue de la Cabine (East Beach) and the Chemin des Fondrières (Graves beach).

The access to animals is forbidden from 9 am to 7 pm from April to September.

Over the Roches Noires cliffs, you'll find 800 m of pedestrian paths with benches, picnic tables, and children's games. This protected natural area welcomes astonishing wild vegetal species, vestiges of the ornamental gardens of past times.

The Roches Noires cliffs



The Roches Noires cliffs, 4 km long and 60 m high, linking Villerville to Trouville-sur-Mer, alternate gentle slopes and steep walls. Exclusively accessible at low tide, they offer a unique landscape owing its name to the blocks of limestone rocks scattered on the sand.

The bunkers

On the beach of Cricqueboeuf, you'll find vestiges of the Atlantic Wall.

At the rhythm of tides

The tidal coefficient tells us the amplitude between high tide and low tide. The coefficients range from 20 for « dead » tides to 120 for exceptional tides. The average tides have a coefficient of about 70. The great tides come when the Moon, the Earth and the Sun are aligned on the same axis. They take place at Autumn and Spring equinoxes.

Reading tide times

The times found in the tide brochure correspond to when the tide reaches its highest or lowest point. There's also a coefficient showing the power and amplitude of this tide.




Two kilometers of beach, 450 beach umbrellas, 450 beach cabins, a seawater Olympic swimming pool, two ports, a tennis club, 22 shops, exhibitions, events; the beach of Deauville is a harbour of happiness for any needs. Represented by Claude Lelouch in the film "A woman and a man", its romantic setting seduces lovers, holiday-makers, bathers, sports makers, horse riders or jockeys all year long.



Take Boulevard Cornuché, then the foreshore parking (several possible options). 
The bathing area stretches over 550 m and is 300 m wide. In July and August, 8 lifeguards owning the BNSSA (Brevet National de Sécurité et de Sauvetage Aquatique) and three CRS monitor the bathing area and the beach.

The Boardwalk

It is one of the most legendary places of Deauville. The Boardwalk, built in 1923, stretches along the foreshore establishment and 450 Art deco cabins. It is 643 m long and is made of Azobe wood. Fences are marked with the names of filmmakers and actors receiving a tribute during the American Film Festival. And it has been lasting since 1975!



Small Anecdote!]

The Boardwalk has been used to host fashion parades! From the 1920s, girls have been parading along the Bar de la Mer and the Pompeian Baths. In 1930, Miss France Yvette Labrousse and European Misses have been creating the event at the Pompeian Baths!

6 The Point de Vue: : built in the 1930s by the Deauville Yacht Club, it turns out to be too far from the municipal port. After having served several purposes, it is now an exhibition place. In summer, it hosts large temporary exhibitions. In winter, the Planche(s) Contact exhibitions, and the Photographic Festival of Deauville are organized here.



Small anecdote...]

After the First World War, women get more independent and in 1919 the method of physical education of the Commandant Hébert, originally elaborated by sailors, succeeded among women along the beach of Tourgéville! At the Palestra Féminine, the female athletes or « athlétesses », as they were called at the time, were dressed with short tunics and were devoted to athletics, gymnastics, boxing or wrestling.

In Bénerville sur-Mer

Not fewer than three beaches to explore: the Lais de Mer Beach, at the border with Tourgéville; the Garenne Beach and the Ammonites beach. The Garenne Beach is the liveliest in the summer season, including a pedestrian walk and a children's club. The Ammonites beach, bigger and wilder, stretches along the Yves-Saint-Laurent beach. It bears the name of the fashion designer that, in 1983, bought the Château Gabriel where the great publisher Gallimard was living.



The beach is accessible from the Lais de Mer Road and its perpendicular roads (avenue Saint-Michel, avenue Maréchal Foch, avenue Victor Caillau). You can park in Rue des Lais de Mer, boulevard de Bénerville, rue Pierre Roucher or even Avenue du Maréchal Foch. Most parking places are for free. You can also find a half-shadowed car park in Avenue du Littoral, at the crossing with Avenue du Général Leclerc, and also a small parking in front of the Terrasse des Ammonnites, 16 boulevard de la Mer.

The access to animals is forbidden from 10 am to 7 pm all year long.

In Blonville sur-Mer

The beach of Blonville-sur-Mer is big! It stretches over 2 km and includes four different areas. Right after Bénerville, it stretches right under the cliffs. The beach Laforge, situated in the city centre, is bordered by small planks leading to a children's club and a sailing club. It's here where you can rent a beach umbrella and deckchairs. The beach of Goblins is the departure point to the west towards the marshes and the natural walks. The west beach, relatively narrow, goes along Villers-sur-Mer, where another history begins. Throughout summer, activities take place on the sand, including castle contests or photographic challenges...



The beach is accessible from the following roads: Rue de Hoinville, Rue Louise, Rue Laforge, Boulevard Marcelle Lechanteur, Rue Pierre Jacquot, Rue Chevalier, Avenue Michel d'Ornano (in front of the beach camping and the marshes). You'll find parking places in the roads reaching the beach and the perpendicular roads. These are places where you can park for free. You can find a car park in the blue parking area between Rue Jean Duchemin and Avenue Michel d'Ornano next to the Centrale chemistry and the Market square.

The access to animals is forbidden from April 1st to September 30th from 10 am to 7 pm.

Outside this schedule, they should be kept at a distance of 100 m from the Boardwalk and the villas. They should be taken on a leash.

In Villers sur-Mer

The beach of Villers-sur-Mer is at the centre of the world... It's the first French city to be crossed by the Greenwich Meridian! The seaside resort reminds the Belle Epoque with picturesque villas going along the beach. Particularity of the beach: the Vaches Noires cliffs, 4.5 km long and 100 m high, dating back to the Jurassic and Cretaceous eras. If you are not fond of history, the beach also hosts several summer events, including the famous Festival Sable Show and sports tournaments are organized all summer long!



The beach is accessible from the Avenue de la République going along the beach, as well as from the Rue Michel d'Ornano and the Rue du Général Leclerc. As these two roads are narrow, it's better to access from the Avenue de la République. You can find parking places on the Avenue de la République and in the perpendicular roads or even behind the Casino Tranchant, Place du Lieutenant Fernand Fanneau. Pay and display car park is also accessible from Place Jean Mermoz, situated in front of Villers-sur-Mer Tourisme. Some more free parking places are accessible from the residential areas, situated some roads away from the sea.

The access to animals is forbidden on the beaches from April 1st to September 30th.

Outside this schedule, dogs are allowed at low tide and must be kept on a leash.

Horses are allowed on the foreshore at low tide from 7 pm to 10 pm from June to September. Outside this schedule, they are allowed before 10 am and after 7 pm.

Cabins, beach umbrellas & deckchairs

Easily recognizable for the white colour, the beach cabins may be rented from June to half-September (140 cabins out of 230 in total can be rented for a day, a week, 15 days, a month or a season).

Swimming

Water under permanent supervision



The quality of water is a real challenge on seaside territories. The Deauville Coast is subjected to careful care. In 2009, the "Communauté de Communes Cœur Côte Fleurie" was rewarded with a "Certification France" for the good management of bathing water. It has implemented its own system of quality measurement complementing the supervision of the "Agence Régionale de la Santé".

The principle: controls are based on the microbiological quality of water. From June to September, 18 samples are taken and analyzed on every beach. A report is published by the A.R.S. and transmitted to the municipalities that are charged with the distribution and posted close to the bathing areas. Appointment at the aid post to see the results.

Seawater all year round

In Deauville, we love so much the sea that it is captured to fill the Olympic swimming pool. The water of the pool (50 m) is pumped offshore and heated up to 28°. Under a vault capturing the light and the sun, eight lifeguards offer swimming courses all year round from 5 years-old, aquagym sessions every day as well as aquatic activities for children every Saturday.

The Municipal Port, hidden in the City Centre

Accessible without entering or exiting a lock basin for 11 hours per day, recreational boaters are very close to shops, restaurants and leisure areas. On the city side, the Deauville Yacht Club and the sailing school are situated along the pool. On the Touques side, you can find the new district of the Presqu'île including a sunny dock, squares and shops. The reorganizational works will continue in 2018 to build new port facilities, namely to better welcome the recreational boaters and those interested in a sailing initiation.





The thalasso of ancient times: rent your cabin

When it was developed in France in 1830, sea bathing was not a leisure activity, but a medical prescription. Dieppe, Trouville-sur-Mer, Villers-sur-Mer, then Deauville from 1860... have become therapeutical destinations.

Sea cabins were built; wooden chalets were placed on the beach, then the Boardwalk going along the seaside was built.

In 1921, the municipality of Deauville launched a renovation contest for this old-fashioned area. The project presented by architect Charles Adda was accepted, as it evoked the memory of the Pompei thermal area. The foreshore establishment was built in 1923 in an Art Déco style. The building had simple volumes made of plastered concrete, covered with mainly blue mosaics.




It was composed of a series of atriums, galleries and mosaics (reminding ancient times) and included 250 cabins, 50 of which were luxurious and had a double service of cold and hot water, a hammam, massage and relax areas, sweating areas. This complex also includes a bar, some shops (book shop, candy shop, clothes and beach games shops). This building makes part of the "Inventaire supplémentaire des monuments historiques". You can always rent a cabin and admire the setting before reaching the beach.






The swimming pool of Deauville, an architectural feat

It is one of the first French projects of the architect Roger Taillibert. This project is for him the first of a series of sports equipment creations, including the Parc des princes stadium in Paris (1967 -1972) and the Olympic complex of Montréal (1972 -1976). He designed his works in his own audacious manner, completely different from the Norman style, which was very popular on the Côte Fleurie at the time, and implemented a system consisting of large-scale thin shells, launched at the beginning of the 1960s and becoming his specialty technique. The sea-water swimming pool was inaugurated in July 1966. Due to high functioning costs, it was likely to close in 1977. It is managed by the municipality since 1980. It was completely renovated in 2006.


