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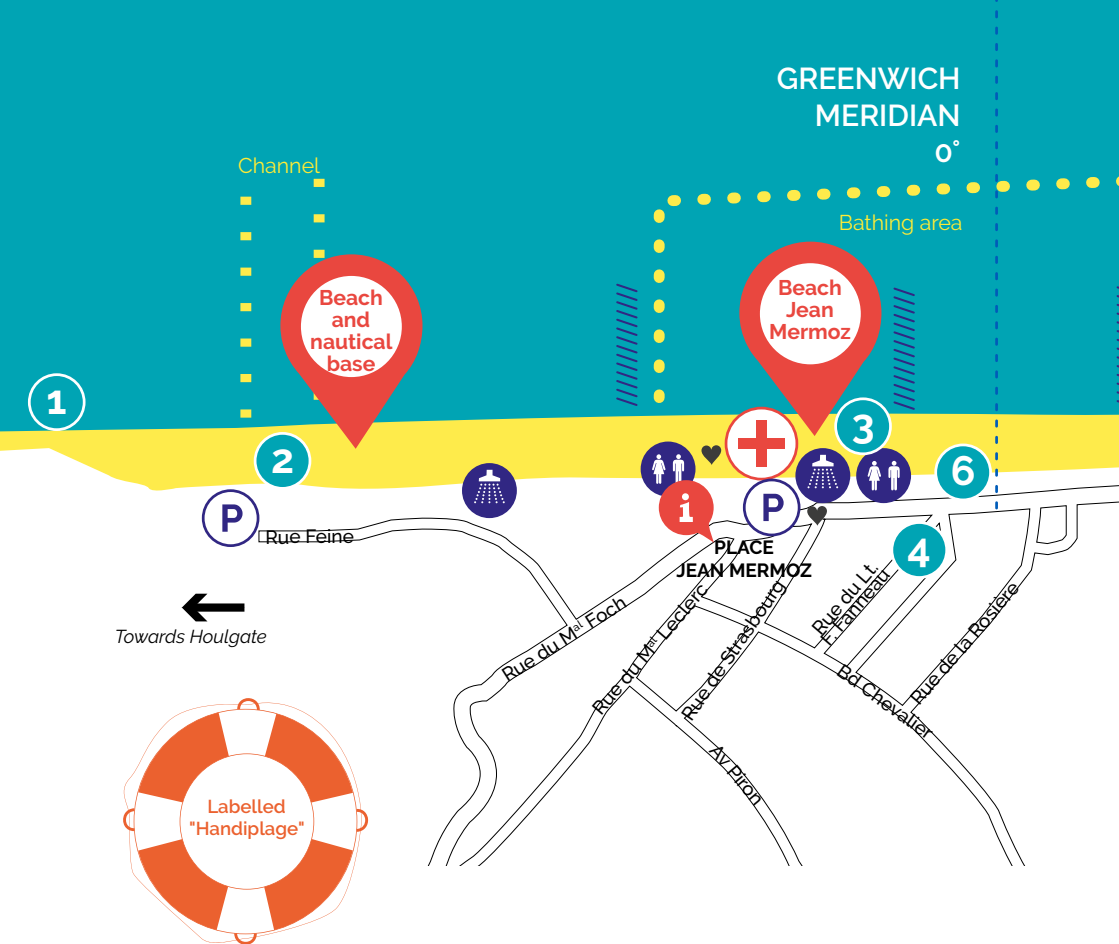
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Admire the sea

Discover the six beaches situated along the inDeauville territory in this guide. They all have a unique atmosphere: familiar, adventurous, sportive, scientific, Californian... but also some common points. The first is the continuous monitoring of the water to ensure an excellent quality. In addition to the national monitoring provided by the *Agence Régionale de Santé*, the inDeauville territory water samples are taken every day from June to September for an even stricter inspection. The style of cabins and the colour of beach umbrellas is another more exotic point that may differ on every beach. In other words, you may enjoy a different setting every day of your holidays.

Villers-sur-Mer, full of history

Here, you are really at the centre of the world! Villers-sur-Mer, the first French city to be crossed by the Greenwich Meridian, has a long beach that is a tribute to the Belle Époque and its picturesque villas. The particularity of this beach are the Vaches Noires cliffs, geological heritage dating back to the Jurassic period. If you are not fond of history, the beach also hosts several summer events, including sports and fun tournaments all summer long!

The beach is accessible from avenue de la République going along the beach, as well as from rue Michel d'Ornano and rue du Général Leclerc. As these two roads are narrow, we suggest to the get there from avenue de la République (paid places in July and August). You can find parking places on the Avenue de la République and in the perpendicular roads or even behind the Casino Tranchant, Place du Lieutenant Fernand Fanneau. A display car park is also accessible from Place Jean Mermoz, situated in front of Villers-sur-Mer Tourisme, only paid in July and August.

From June 15th to September 15th dogs are allowed before 9 am and after 8 pm at the edges of the beach. Outside this schedule, from September 16th to June 14th, they are allowed on the beach. Dogs can run free on the beach, but must be kept on a leash on the Boardwalk.

Horses are allowed on the foreshore at low tide from June to September from 7 pm to 10 pm. Outside this schedule, they are allowed before 10 am and after 7 pm.

The musts...

1 Walk along the Vaches Noires cliffs.

During a guided tour, discover the unexpected secrets of this palaeontological gem and enjoy collecting fossils and other treasures. Check dates and hours on en.indeauville.fr. And to go further, visit the Paléospace, a museum dedicated to local paleontology which exhibits fossils dating from the Jurassic period.

2 Attend a sand yachting course.

Villers-sur-Mer, with its endless fine sand beach, is the perfect place to discover sand yachting. Catch the wind, take off on two wheels and feel the breeze on your face. An adrenaline rush! (see page 31).

Take a selfie on the Greenwich Meridian.

At a marked point on the seaside, longitude is exactly 0: it means that you are at the centre of the world. It's the perfect place to take a photo!

Towards Villers-sur-Mer

Blonville-sur-Mer, a paradise for children

The Blonville-sur-Mer beach, accessible from the city centre, is bordered by small planks leading to a children's club and a sailing club. Here, you can rent entirely white cabins and white-and-blue beach umbrellas situated opposite breath-taking seaside villas. Further away, you'll find the wilder Goblins beach, the departure point for the marsh and its nature walks, followed by Villers-sur-Mer where another story begins.



The beach is accessible from the following roads: rue de Hoinville, rue Louise, rue Laforge, boulevard Marcelle Lechanteur, rue Pierre Jacquot, rue Chevalier, avenue Michel d'Ornano (in front of the beach camping and the marshes).

You'll find parking places in the roads reaching the beach and the perpendicular roads. These are places where you can park for free.

You can find a car park in the blue parking area between rue Jean Duchemin and avenue Michel d'Ornano next to the Centrale chemistry and the Market square.

Animals are not allowed from April 1st to September 30th from 10 am to 7 pm.

Outside this schedule, they should be kept 100 m away from the Boardwalk and the villas.

Unmissable destination in summer for children from the age of 4, the Beach club of Blonville-sur-Mer has zip lines, trampolines, inflatable structures, jumping pits, and slides where children can jump, bounce, roll and laugh. The club also offers 20-minute swimming lessons in a heated indoor learning pool. Open in summer, it's the first approach to swimming for children who are just learning to swim safely. The older ones can also try out the pool a few meters away!

Bénéreville-sur-Mer, the Californian beach

Here, you can find three beaches to explore: the Lais de Mer beach, near Tourgéville, the Garenne beach, a very dynamic beach with a children's club and a restaurant, and the Ammonites beach, to reach Blonville-sur-Mer on a low tide.



The beach is accessible from the Lais de Mer Road and its perpendicular roads (avenue Saint-Michel, avenue Maréchal Foch, avenue Victor Caillau).

You can park in Rue des Lais de Mer, boulevard de Bénerville, rue Pierre Roucher or even Avenue du Maréchal Foch. Most parking places are for free.

You can also find a half-shadowed car park in Avenue du Littoral, at the crossing with Avenue du Général Leclerc, and a small parking in front of the Terrasse des Ammonites, 16 boulevard de la Mer.

Animals are not allowed from 10 am to 7 pm all year long.

Dogs are allowed on Yves Saint-Laurent Boardwalk if they are kept on a leash.

The musts

Take a photo of the aid station.

With a Californian look made of wooden poles, it attracts curious people and photo lovers to the Lais de Mer beach. It's even nicer at sunset!



Go up on the Mont-Canisy

This panorama offers a breathtaking view from Ouistreham to Le Havre. We like to stare at the horizon to track down the green flesh at sunset.

Walk between the sea and the villas.

At the end of the boardwalk, you can continue your walk and reach Bénerville-sur-Mer through the Lais de Mer promenade. The seaside becomes a playground where children play, lovers flirt, holiday makers take photos and athletes play sports.

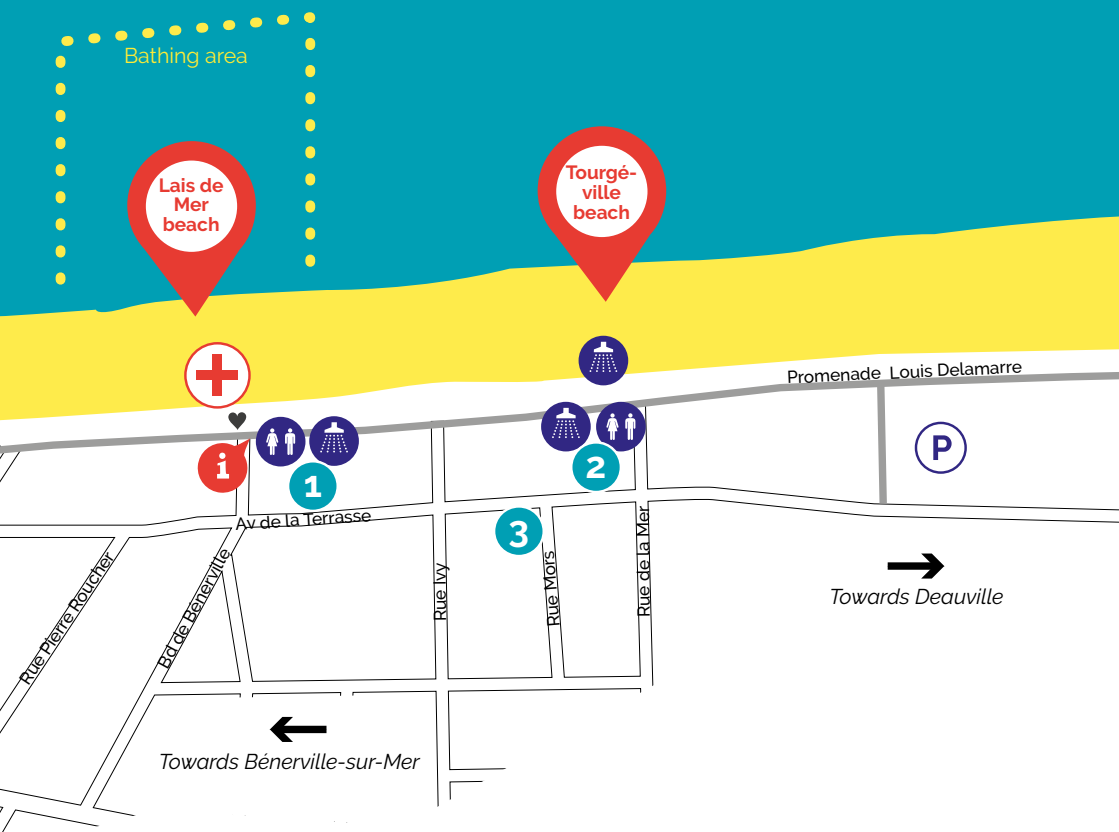

Tourgéville, a bucolic beach

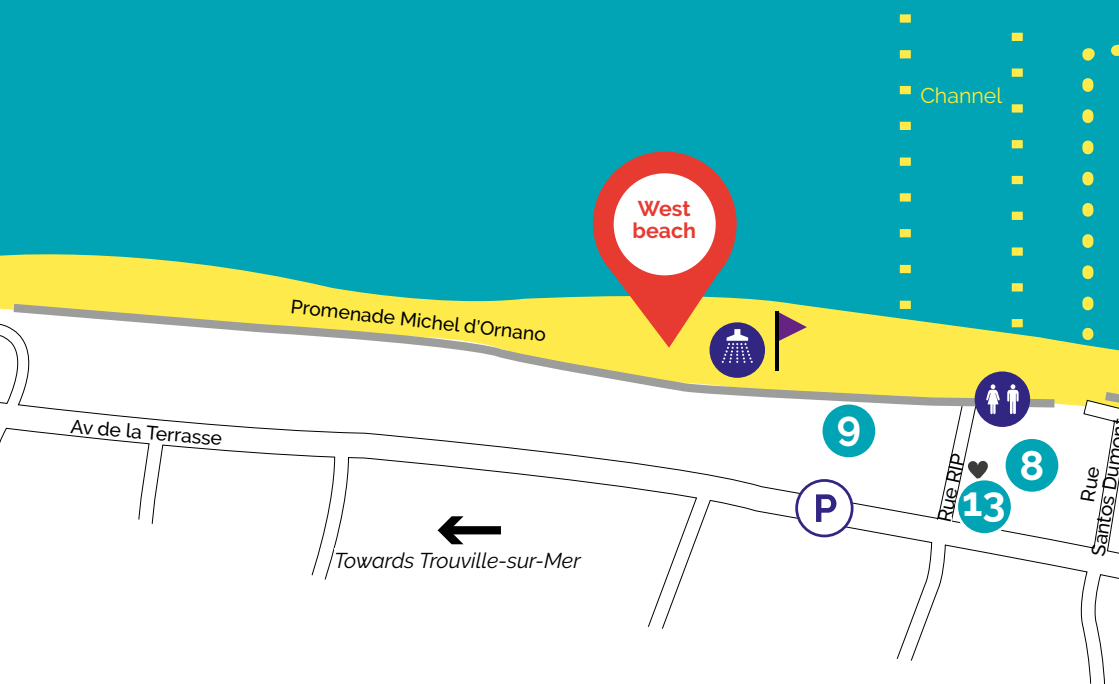

The romantic Deauville beach

The Deauville beach meets any needs: a 2-km-long beach with 450 beach umbrellas, 450 cabins, sports fields, a children's club, a leisure park, and 22 shops. Shot by Claude Lelouch in the film titled "A Man and a Woman", its romantic setting seduces lovers, holidaymakers, bathers, sports makers, horse riders and jockeys all year long.



Take boulevard Cornuché then the Lais de Mer car park (several entrances possible).







Saddle and domestic animals are permitted from May 1 to September 30 before 10 am and after 7 pm, then from October 1 to April 30 without time restrictions.

Board the little tourist train from Deauville to reach the seafront, at the level of Boards, while visiting the city's must-sees during a 40-minute stroll.

The little tourist train takes you from mid-April to September and during all school holidays from zone C.

The musts

Walk along the Planches and its Art déco atmosphere (1923).

The Planches border the Pompeii Baths establishment and its Art Deco cabins. This set, signed Charles Adda, is inspired by models from Antiquity while being part of modernity through clean lines, the use of concrete punctuated with mosaics. The lists are marked with the names of the directors and actors invited each year to the American Film Festival. And it has been going on since 1975!

See the spectacle of horses.

They come here early in the morning or at sunset to relax after a training session, a race, or a competition.

Rent a beach umbrella or an Art Déco cabin in Deauville.

The deauville parasol is probably the most photographed parasol in the world with its five colors. Cabins and umbrellas can be rented at the establishment of sea bathing (see page 25).



The Parc des Lais de Mer, a garden along the beach

After the boardwalk, Planches, go around the Michel d'Ornano promenade towards the Parc des Lais de Mer, a large seaside 4-ha park that has become the favourite playground for swimmers, holidaymakers, and athletes. You can meet here to take a walk or to enjoy the free sport path and the skate park. Lovers enjoy the "Jardin des cœurs" to hang a padlock, exchange promises and share secrets. What are you waiting for?



For kids

A dynamic team, made up of different talents and united around the love of children for successful holidays, this is the promise of the Deauville Plein Air leisure center. The wild beach of Villerville

Unsupervised beach

Shore fishing of shellfish is forbidden all year long in the municipality of Villerville.

Find the local authority decrees in the website of Pêche à Pied du Calvados and Calvados.gouv.fr

The narrow and coloured roads of Villerville, a typical village with a picturesque centre, stretch down to the sea and two beaches: the Graves beach to the west and the Bains beach to the east. The latter is not accessible at high tide but you can walk along it on the dike which dominates it and observe the Roches Noires cliffs.



The access from the centre of Villerville is hard by car. We recommend reaching the beach on foot from rue de la Cabine (East Beach) or chemin des Fondrières (Graves beach).

Car parks at Place du Lavoir and behind the town hall are paid only in season.

Dogs are not allowed from June 15 to August 31 from 9 am to 7 pm. It is however allowed on the Boardwalk if they are kept on a leash. Horses are not allowed from June 15 to August 31 between the Cabane Bleue and the nautical base.



Parc des Graves

The Parc des Graves, from the top of the cliffs to the sea

From the Parc des Graves, you can go down to the sea through a lane that starts at the top of the Roches Noires cliffs and enjoy many other paths. A remarkable flora is found: rare and wild plants, remnants of ornamental gardens of olden times, recent flower beds and ponds. This peaceful place to have a stroll, is also great to relax or have fun. It's a sort of children's playground where picnic tables and pétanque courts are waiting for you.

Incontournables

Ride at the bottom of the Roches Noires cliffs.

Partially ranked «Espace Naturel Sensible», the Roches Noires cliffs stretch over 4 km between Trouville-sur-Mer and Villerville. Horse riders can see more or less steep cliffs, nature, reefs, wooden areas, and, if you're lucky, fossils (see page 26).

Gather shrimps by hand.

On fresh, dry, or sunny days, shore fishing is done in Villerville all year round. Equipped with landing nets and buckets, seek grey shrimps, crustaceans and other species hidden in the sandy foreshore.

Wander on the promenade.

Along the 450 m-long Villerville dyke, you can walk below the village built along the cliffs.

Rent a beach cabin or a beach umbrella

Cabins on Villers-sur-Mer beach

A luxury for some people, a family tradition handed down from generation to generation for others, beach cabins have long been used as small secondary houses. Located as close to the sea as possible, these cabins are perfect to store beach equipment, wear a paddle suit or eat sheltered from the wind... We admire the modern architecture of these art déco-style Deauville cabins with pure lines and mosaic decors. At the bottom of the picturesque villas of Villers-sur-Mer and Bonville-sur-Mer, the beach cabins are easily recognisable for their immaculate shiny white colour; in a completely different style, white and blue dominate on the cabins of Bénerville-sur-Mer.

Another must on the beach in summer are the famous beach umbrellas. While lying on the sand or on a deck chair, you can enjoy the shadow provided by beach umbrellas on hot days. Beach umbrellas have a different look on every beach: blue and white stripes in Blonville-sur-Mer and Tourgéville, five different plain colours with a knot in Deauville.

Enjoy the benefits of sea water

Thalasso Deauville by Algotherm

SURROUNDED BY BUBBLES IN A THALASSO CENTRE

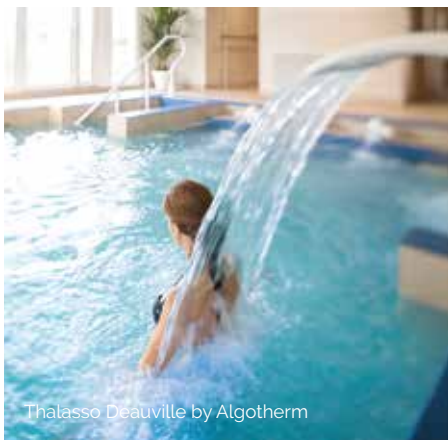
When it was developed in France in the 19th century, sea bathing was not a leisure practice nor the opportunity to admire the beauty of the beaches: sea baths were taken for medical reasons. Physicians had discovered that sea water, rich in magnesium, calcium, and potassium, had virtues that could heal several illnesses. Throughout the years, when the first hydrotherapy centre was built in 1862, the bains pompéiens and the Boardwalk in 1923, sea water became a source of wellness for the inDeauville territory. These two thalassotherapy centres found along the seaside perpetuate the sea bathing tradition started about 200 years ago. SWIMMING IN SEA WATER ALL YEAR ROUND

The Deauville swimming pool was built more recently, in 1966, by architect Roger Taillibert. The 50 m-long pool is filled with sea water pumped offshore and heated to 28° C all year long. Under a vault which captures the sun and the light, it is the gathering place of nearly 85,000 swimmers every year. With concrete sails and curves, the outside of the swimming pool looks like a shell lying on the beach and facing the sea, safe from marine winds. Inside, an immense vault captures sun and light. It's the perfect place to swim, train or attend an aqua gym class.

ASEA WALK

Sea walking, as well as sand walking, has many benefits. This is why the beach is a wonderful place to train! Nordic walking and longe-côte courses are provided all year long on the inDeauville beaches. The longe-côte, invigorating aquatic walking, consists in walking in the sea immersed up to the waist. Equipped with suits, and sometimes even paddles, you can sculpt your whole body with every movement. Under water pressure, abdominal and lumbar muscles, and legs are more solicited than during a hike. And by breathing the marine air at the top of your lungs, you'll stimulate blood flow and benefit from the trace elements of salt water.

What to see in Le Havre?

Le Havre, a UNESCO World Heritage city, is impressive for its cultural heritage and for a unique architecture imagined by the visionary Auguste Perret. As soon as you arrive, walk along the quay up to the Musée d'Art Moderne André Malraux. As Impressionism is widely represented there, the museum has the second largest collection in France, right after Musée d'Orsay in Paris. Then, stroll in the Quartier Perret and head towards Le Volcan, cultural area and national auditorium that now hosts the Oscar Niemeyer library. Just a short walk from here, do not miss the Saint-Joseph church that looks like a New York skyscraper with its octagonal lantern tower and 6,500 coloured stained-glass windows. End your day on the pebble beach bordered with restaurants, bars, and coloured cabins.

Going from Trouville to Deauville and the other way round is easy. For € 1.20, sail on board the Trait d'Union, a small boat linking the two towns when the tide is high. A must-see attraction from the construction of Deauville in 1860, the Trouville-Deauville ferryboat takes people on board on the two banks of the Touques river, making both towns looking a little like a Northern Venice. By the way, the ferryboat finds its origin in 1889, when the Deauville Casino's clients wanted to take the shorter way to go from one town to the other. With a blazing sun or under the rain, the visitors are warmly welcomed by Emmanuel Guillet, called «Manu du bac» by the locals and captain of the ferryboat for 26 years now. On board, the main topics are the markets, the villas, the beach, the activities, the preserved urban environment, and shopping. Fun fact: it's the shortest crossing in France with 220 meters in 3 minutes!

THE MUNICIPAL PORT, AT THE HEART OF DEAUVILLE

Protected by winter storms, the municipal port is located in the heart of the city, 300 m away from the Place Morny, in front of the railway station. It is composed of two ponds: Bassin Morny and Bassin des Yachts. About 400 boats are moored here during the year, plus 60 guest boats. Recreational boaters are very close to shops, restaurants, and leisure areas, but also to the heart of the Presqu'île district with sunny river edges and squares. In 2020, new port facilities were placed on each side of the footbridge that links the ponds: two 28 m-high lookout points mark a "sea door" and overlook the estuary. At the bottom, you'll find the port authorities, a sailing school, areas reserved to amateur sailors, and the Deauville Yacht Club.

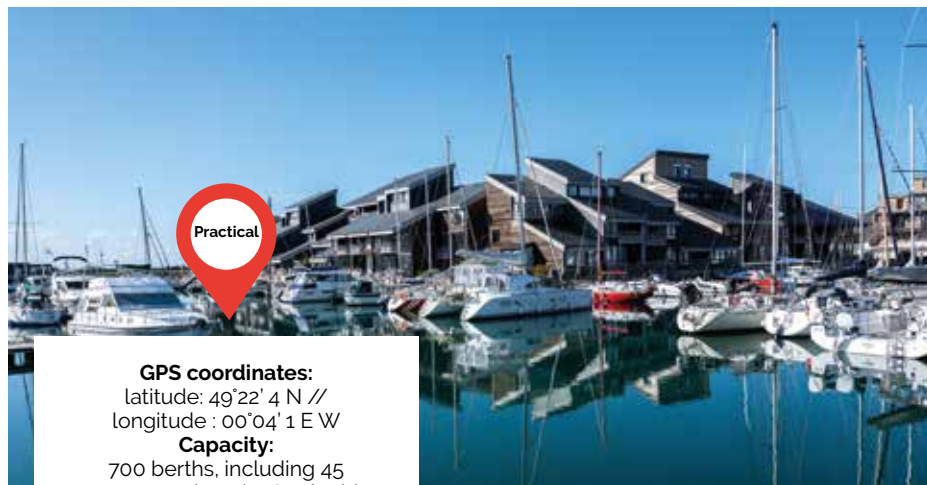

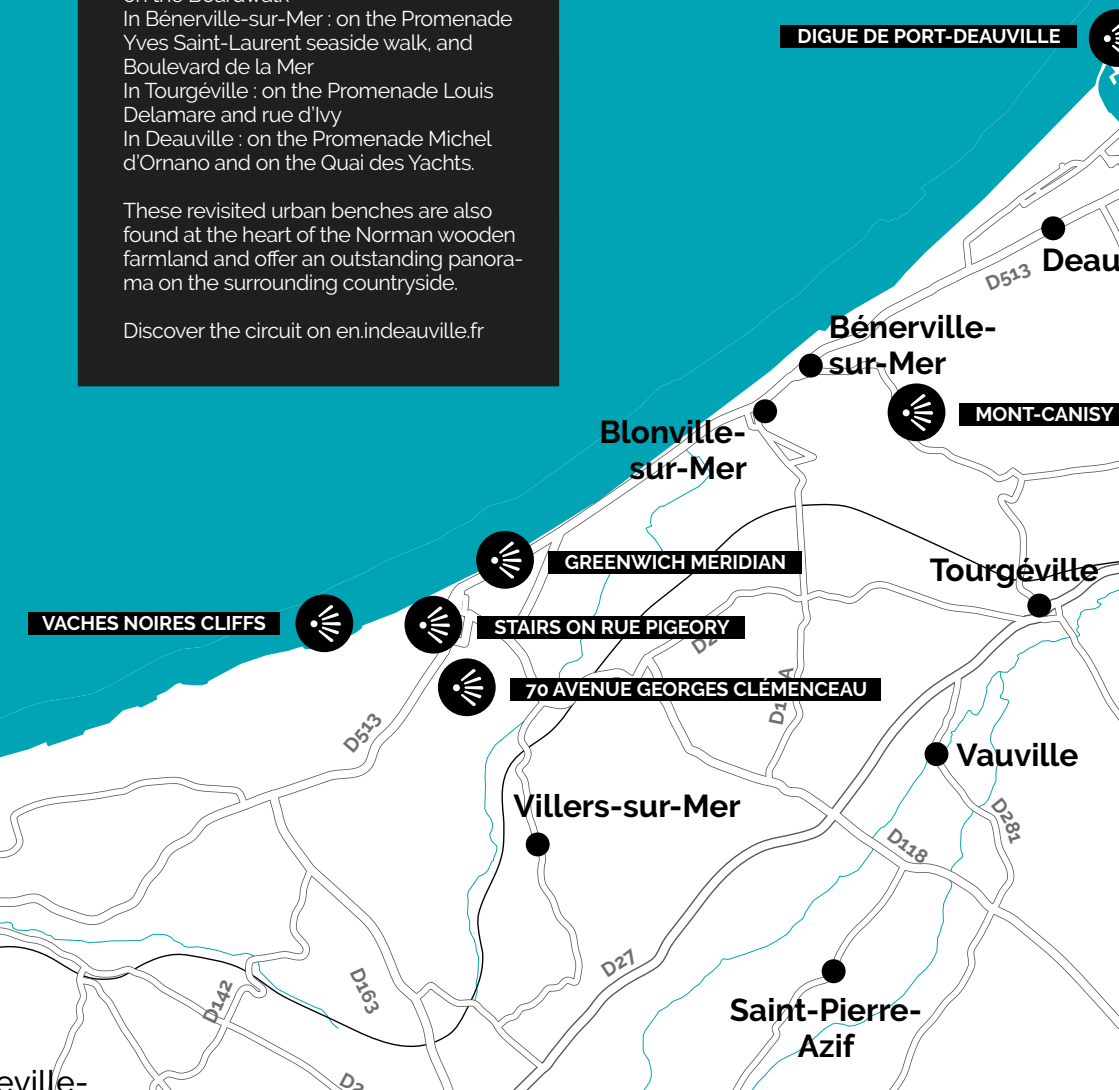

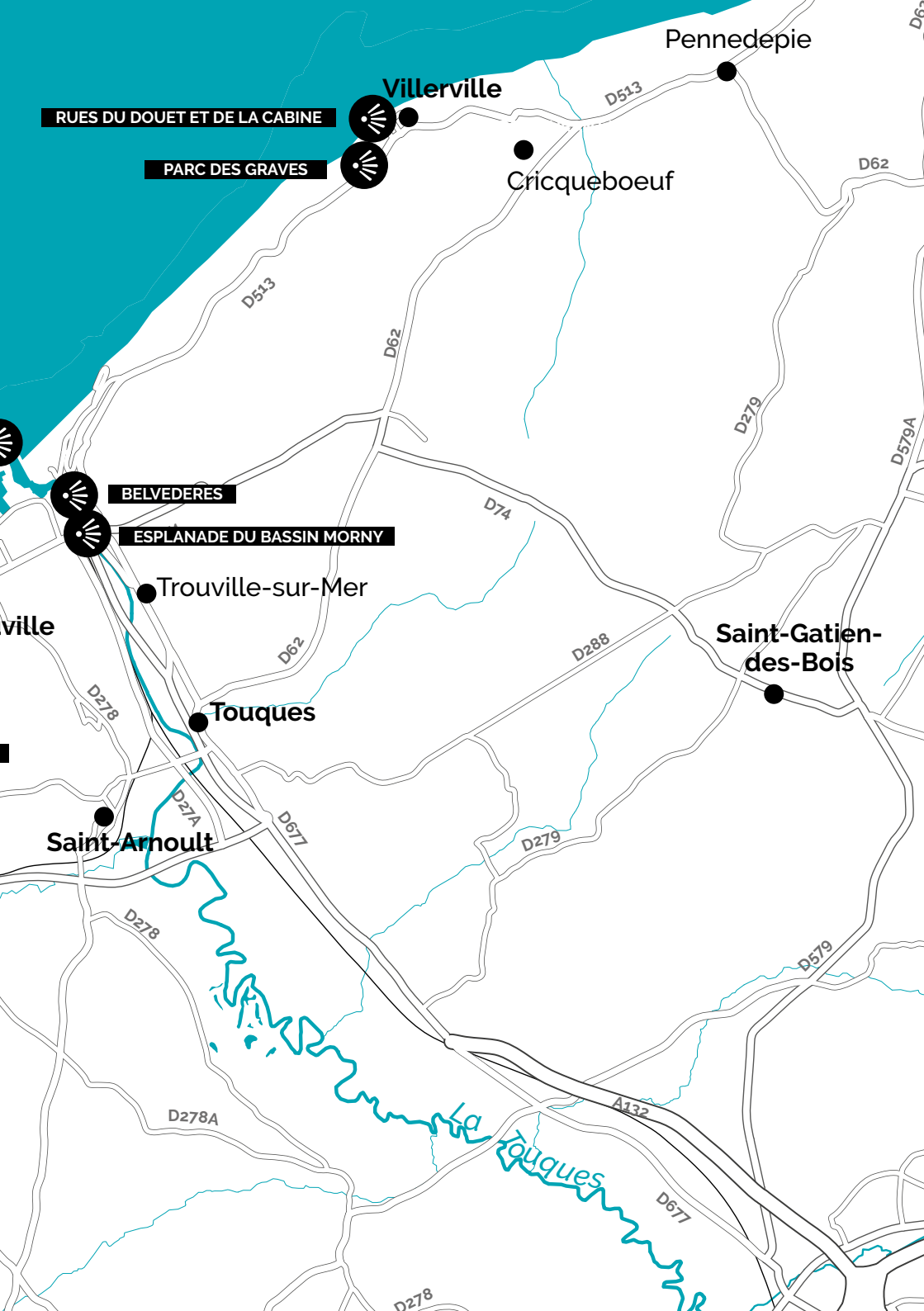
