## **The kingdom of horses**

# Where to see horses ?

## 2 - At the Elie de Brignac Hall

It's the first auction room of thoroughbred horses in France. Many horse auctions are held here during the year, including the famous August Yearling Sale. If you follow the rules, you can admire the horses presented in the ring.



## On the villas' roofs

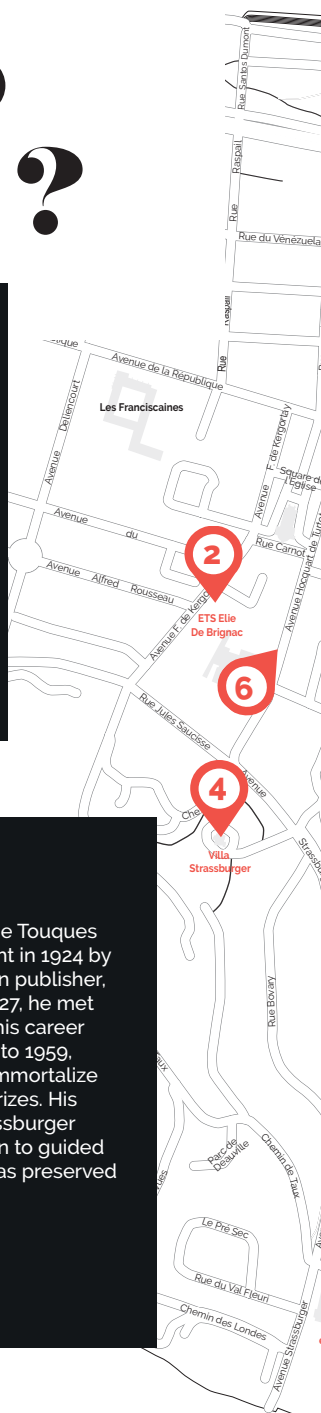
Little horses are often portrayed on the finials (ornamental elements made of metal or ceramics) of Deauville villas. Look up to see them while you're strolling around.



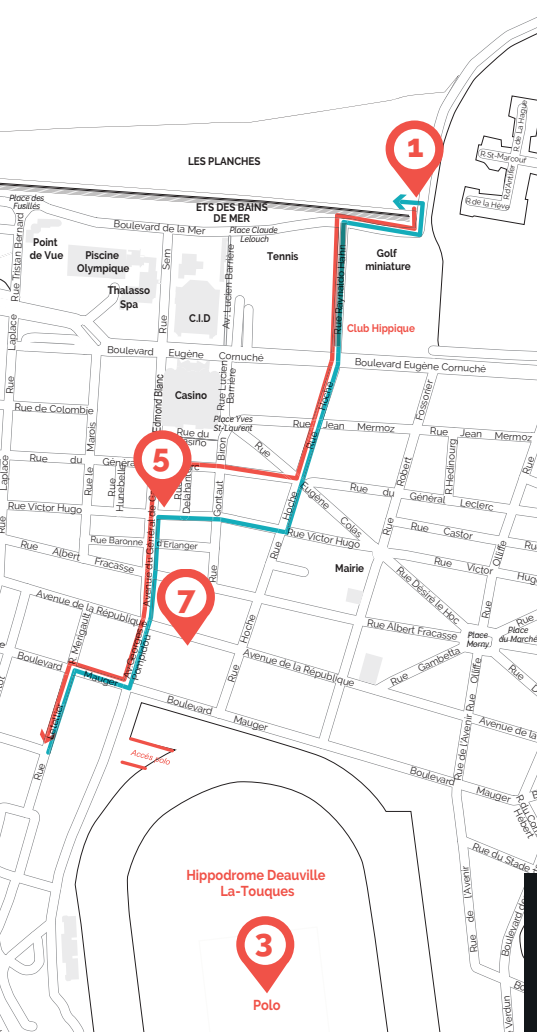
## 4 - At the Strassburger Villa

This imposing residence overlooks the Touques racecourse. Built in 1907, it was bought in 1924 by Ralph Beaver Strassburger - American publisher, breeder and racing enthusiast -. In 1927, he met Ignace Konrad, who had just started his career in animal painting in Paris. From 1948 to 1959, Strassburger hired him to paint and immortalize his race horses that had won major prizes. His paintings are on the walls of the Strassburger Villa, now owned by the City and open to guided tours. As it rarely happens, the Villa has preserved the furniture of the time.

## 1 - On foot on the roads of Deauville

Walk along the Deauville-La Touques racecourse, taking Rue Hocquart de Turtot or Rue Letellier to see the stables of the horse-training centre:

400 horses – 700 in summer – are hosted here to be trained by the best professionals. You can see them galloping in the morning from Boulevard Mauger.

Horses often reach the beach to relax in sea water. They take the bridle path (in red and blue on the map).

In summer, there are more horses, including polo horses. They are ridden back and forth the polo fields and the beach in the morning and in the evening and also on the city centre roads in the mornings of the matches.

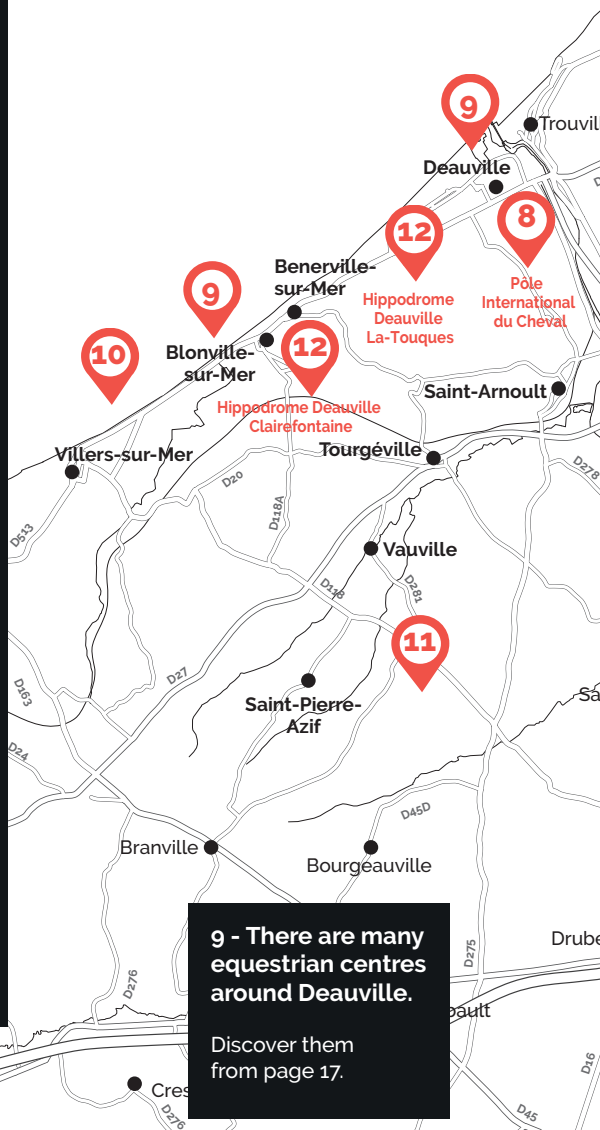

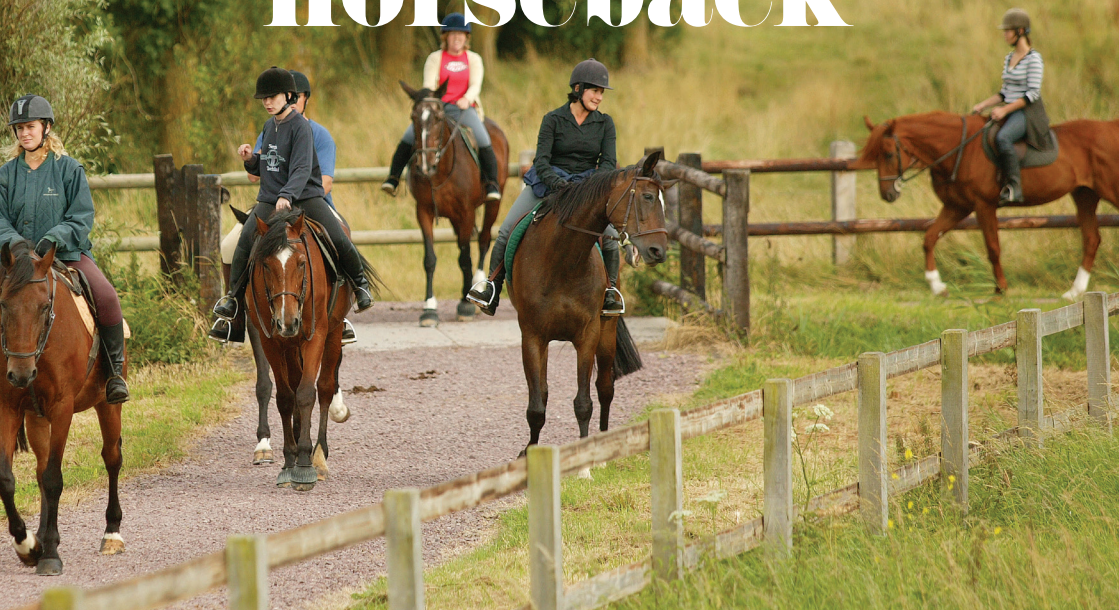

# Take a tour on a horseback



Three spots to discover on a horseback

## THE MARSH OF BLONVILLE-SUR-MER/ VILLERS-SUR-MER AN EXTRAORDINARY SETTING

Located in the East of Villers-sur-mer, along the municipality of Blonville-sur-mer, the marshes of Blonville-Villers are the only natural green area of the Côte Fleurie. This place of great ecological richness includes 110 hectares of wet grasslands, canals and ditches. Despite its proximity to the sea, it is a freshwa-

ter marsh fed by streams that come from the hillsides around.

Part of the marshes around Villers-sur-Mer has been rehabilitated from 1975. A water body and almost 5 km of paths welcome strollers and riders.



## MONT-CANISY: A PANORAMA ON THE COAST

Located on the heights of Deauville, in Bénerville-sur-mer, the 110-m-high Mont-Canisy offers an extraordinary panorama overlooking the Côte Fleurie. The Mont-Canisy has been a seigniorial domain for centuries and is today a natural site protected by the Conservatoire du littoral, which preserves its flora and fauna. It is also a place loaded with history. During the Second World War, it was an important artillery spots of the "Atlantic Wall". Several vestiges are a proof of it.

## THE ROCHES NOIRES CLIFFS: A SENSITIVE AREA

From Trouville-sur-mer to Villerville, 4 km of clay cliffs border the coast with gentle slopes and vertical walls reaching 60 m in height. This 135-ha area - called "Roches Noires" cliffs - is classified as part of the Espace Naturel Sensible. The seaside cliffs are always changing. This instability leads to the development of pioneer vegetation. Rocky reef flats also host several species of birds making this site a privileged migration and overwintering site.

## **G**ALLOPING ON WET SAND

# Riding lessons

Where to find them

## Ecuries de la Villedieu



This domain of over 35 hectares is situated on the heights of Villers-sur-Mer. Nicolas Martin, instructor-trainer, shares his passion for riding since 2002. Stables are located in the former farm of a castle. They have preserved Norman architecture with half-timbered structures that are typical of the region.

About thirty horses are hosted in this peaceful area where Nicolas and Emilie Carregari provide riding lessons and help both adults and children learn how to gallop. Riders may challenge themselves during Club contests that Nicolas would like to develop soon.

The riding centre, ideally situated at the heart of a forest, organizes assisted horseback tours in open air for any age and levels. The most experienced (3-4 level gallop min.) riders may enjoy a horseback tour on the beach of Villers-sur-Mer.

This activity was love at first sight for Nicolas Martin, during his first ride at the age of 10. He attended the Ecole Nationale des Haras at Haras du Pin, then the Garde Républicaine. He started taking care of horses and leading them to participate in jumping national and international competitions.

## Centre équestre de Blonville-sur-Mer

It is common to run into horses and ponies at the heart of the marsh of Blonville-Villers. Just across the marsh, you can find an equestrian centre accessible to everybody.

It was founded 25 years ago. About 30 horses, double-ponies and shetlands enjoy the natural environment during group tours in the heart of the marshes, on the heights of Mont-Canisy or in the Pays d'Auge countryside (only accessible to those over the age of 12). Horseback tours on the beach, right by the Club, are also very popular (exclusively for 2 to 4 level gallop riders)!

For children: a pony initiation is highly recommended before starting riding lessons and intensive courses. Several formulas are proposed to riders of different levels.

Vincent Pawlowski has been managing this riding centre passionately since July 2015. About 20 years ago, he started working in Deauville before creating his own riding club in Pont-l'Évêque. At that time, he focused on competitions. He won the Hunter Normandy Championship (a jumping contest).

## Club Hippique la mangeoire

Situated very close to the beach for over 60 years, this club has preserved the structure of a past time, strongly appreciated by the parents and grandparents who accompany their children and grandchildren. They are glad to discover the 10-minute pony initiations and riding courses accessible to children over 6. Daily or weekly courses combine theory and practice to prepare you for horse riding. But the most fascinating offer for occasional or regular visitors are beach galloping tours, both accessible to beginners and experienced riders.

Mélanie, who joined the Riding Club as an instructor a year ago, has already found her feet. Passionate about horses since she was 3, she was into business before reconverting to horse riding. She obtained her instructor degree close to Caen. As someone who loves challenges, she participated in jumping and eventing competitions before trying the hunter contest and joining, the amateur championships this year.

## Ferme des Galopins

The name of this place is just perfect! Horses, ponies, hens, pigs, goats, dogs and even a lama...live at the Ferme des Galopins, where Anne, specialist of psychomotricity and positive pedagogy, organizes courses, intensive courses and initiations that are adjusted to suit every child and based on fun teaching methods. Baby-pony is much more than an initiation. Accessible to children over 2, it requires being acquainted with the whole world of horses: specific vocabulary, grooming equipment, riders' reflexes, etc.

Born in a family in which riding was omnipresent - her father was a farrier - Anne was studying photography before converting to riding instructorship. Her family was extremely happy about it. She studied at the International Equestrian Complex in Deauville and worked there for several years before starting her own company: 6 ponies belonging to private individuals or from riding centres, a lunge ring and a covered riding arena which she renovated herself. Three years later, the club has about 20 ponies, some farm animals and loyal clients contribute to reaffirm the identity of this place.

## Ecuries Bellifontaines

Acquired and renovated in 2017 by Elodie Levy, the Ecuries de Bellifontaines are perched on the heights of Villerville, close to the forest. The ambitious owner has already provided this equestrian domain with a large covered riding arena, renovated tracks, paddocks and a club-house. Anybody over 3 can ride here, whatever their level. Baby-pony, riding courses and one-day or half-day intensive courses for children from the age of 5-6 are offered. Celebrating birthdays here is very common with snacks, riding initiations, horseback tours... The beach of Villerville, accessible to horses any time on low tide, is the perfect place to take a tour on the bottom of the Roches Noires cliffs. Elodie also works for the owners' horses that she trains to prepare them for contests.

Elodie was able to ride even before walking. After obtaining her instructorship degree in La Baule, she came back to Fontainebleau to manage the Ecuries de Bellifontaine. But her dream was to move to Côte Fleurie, leading destination for equestrian sports. Her dream came true when she met the owner of the Ecuries de Villerville, a place she loves.

## Private courses with... **Samuel Catel**



### **T**HE RIDING CENTRE

The Haras du Manoir, which doubles as a riding school and a private stable, prepares horses for jumping contests, a discipline with increasing popularity. In 2016, six out of them were selected for the Pony and Club France Championships. The equestrian school welcomes horse lovers that are always eager to learn and enjoy competitions, who come to train.

Samuel also works with children over 4 who attend riding lessons once per week. Weekends are very dynamic. The team of three people during the year organize trekking tours, competition games and horseback tours in open air. The centre has 90 horses.



## PORTRAIT

Samuel Catel, originally from the Picardie region, fell in love with riding when he was a child. He craved to join the Garde Républicaine, but unfortunately lost part of his right leg after a car accident. After the accident, his passion for riding became even stronger and, once he left the hospital, he attended a course to learn how to manage a farm and work in this field. Then, he had a life-changing encounter when he met Frédéric Aguilhaume, rider and France's Handisport champion of amateur jumping, who is currently an instructor. He taught him how to ride again and transmitted the desire to share knowledge to him. Samuel obtained the trainer-instructor diploma while participating in competitions at the same time. High-level athlete for 10 years, he was a member of the French Paradressage Team before reconverting to his favourite discipline, jumping. He and his wife Marie saw an enormous potential in the more than 30 hectares domain they bought in Saint-Pierre-Azif.

Passionate about horses since he was a child, Bertrand Lebarbier quickly acquired experience on the job and joined the Garde Républicaine in 1991. He rapidly joined the dressage competition riding centre and redoubled his efforts to become a high-level athlete. Then, he decided to share his passion and took a management position

at the dressage department of the cavalry regiment.

Twenty years later, he moved to Deauville with his family to keep sharing his passion. At the Longines Deauville International Equestrian Complex, he is a rider and professional instructor of dressage, his favourite discipline. He also trains riders for jumping and eventing competitions. Intensive courses, upgrading or coaching lessons to prepare future competitors: all formulas are available. His suggestion to help riders reach their objectives: don't give up, because patience and rigour are essential to reach excellence in dressage.

**Pierre Fleury**



Born in a family of riding and jumping lovers, Pierre Fleury rode a horse for the first time when he was 4. As a riding enthusiast, he started focusing on dressage when his father bought two Highlands, Nessy and Nelson, to train them together. At the same time, an intensive course in ethology convinced him that his professional career would be in riding. Carefully observing horses and spending time with them was a great way for him to understand them better. What about his dressage technique? Horses in freedom without halters, saddles or lead rein and a rider who adapts to the horse.

Pivotal moment in his career: in 2009, the President of Highland race asked him to participate in two dressage acts at the French Championship taking place at Haras du Pin. The encouragement of the public led him to follow his passion. Pierre Fleury astonished the public by participating in TV programs, acts, encounters and new shows. He also organized intensive courses and dressage courses. His principle: learn how to better communicate with horses, leave them free and be able to reproduce tours that are worthy of great shows!

It's the temple of equestrian sports. Paddocks, stables, outdoor and indoor arenas stretch over almost 9 ha to offer riders and horse lovers a personalized and high-quality service. ## HIGH-LEVEL PARA-EQUESTRIAN DRESSAGE IS CELEBRATED EVERY YEAR IN SPRING

For 3 days, para-equestrian dressage riders - about one hundred horse/rider pairs in total (from 15 countries) - are shown on the rectangle, according to their level of disability (grade I to IV) and compete in 3 different races: Team Test (Coupe des Nations, team competition), Individual championship (Coupe des Nations, imposed test) and Freestyle (freestyle with music).

## JUMP'IN DEAUVILLE: INTERNATIONAL JUMPING CONTEST ORGANIZED EVERY YEAR IN JUNE

About twenty countries meet in Normandy to compete in a CSI 1\*, a CSI 2\* and a CSI YH reserved to young 7-year-old horses. In total, nearly 100 riders and 400 horses are shared across the 3 levels of the competition. The CSI 2\* competitions will offer remarkable highlights, but the CSI 1\* will also count on the presence of some French and foreign good riders...



## DRESS'IN DEAUVILLE: AN INTERNATIONAL DRESSAGE CONTEST, IS ORGANIZED EVERY YEAR IN MID-JULY

French and foreign dressage athletes and hopes of worldwide dressage meet for the 4th step of the "FFE Dress Tour" circuit, a FFE circuit including the 6 leading international dressage contests in France. The public can enjoy a wide range of performances on imposed or freestyle tests.



## DEAUVILLE LONGINES CLASSIC, AN INTERNATIONAL JUMPING CONTEST, IS ORGANIZED BY MID-AUGUST

For 4 days, sport and lifestyle are combined during this unique competition taking place at the Longines Deauville International Equestrian Complex. About twenty countries compete; the leading characters of the discipline participate in the international contest 3\* with professional and amateur riders, together with future cracks in 1\* and young horse contests; a large and passionate public attends the races; the Longines Race challenges jumping jockeys and riders. Here are the ingredients that make it successful.





# Attend a polo match

Good to know

Three indoor tournaments are also organized at the Longines Deauville International Equestrian Complex in winter.

Polo is played in Deauville since the end of the 19th century. A renowned polo tournament in France is the "Coupe d'Or", with the finals of the worldwide championship held in Deauville and gathering the protagonists of international polo. Three tracks situated at the heart of the La Touques racecourse in Deauville are available to players. The tournament takes place yearly in August. After the first tournament held in 1950, the Silver Cup, the Bronze Cup and the Ladies Cup - particularly popular - were added. Players enjoy meeting the public.

They often organize beach polo matches on the beach of Deauville and love parading in the city, when the sun shines, making regular stops.

You may also see them riding on the foreshore early in the morning. It's amazing!

Matches are open to the public and held for 25 days in August in the afternoon. The final match of the famous Golden Cup is always scheduled after the "Grand Prix de Deauville" equestrian race, on the last weekend of August. All matches are commented and explained, often with a note of irony.

### A small anecdote...

The polo club was founded in 1907. In 1912, one of the members of the steering committee of the club was Arthur Capel known as Boy Capel, who was in love with Gabrielle Chanel. She would have opened her first hat boutique in Rue Gontaut-Biron on the following year. Gabrielle, a good rider, never missed a match of her brilliant lover. In 1923, the polo club of Deauville already had over 50 players. Alfonso XII, King of Spain, and Winston Churchill were members too.

Later, the Jaipur maharajah came to play tournaments on Deauville fields: players wore turbans and horses silk martingales. The Prince of Wales has been guest of honour since 1977.

With the support of the Fédération Française d'Equitation and the Fédération Française de Polo, young players can improve their level in any season. The polo school has an extraordinary environment. Polo is played indoor at the Olympic arena of the Longines Deauville International Equestrian Complex, on the beach or on the grass at the Deauville-La Touques racecourse.

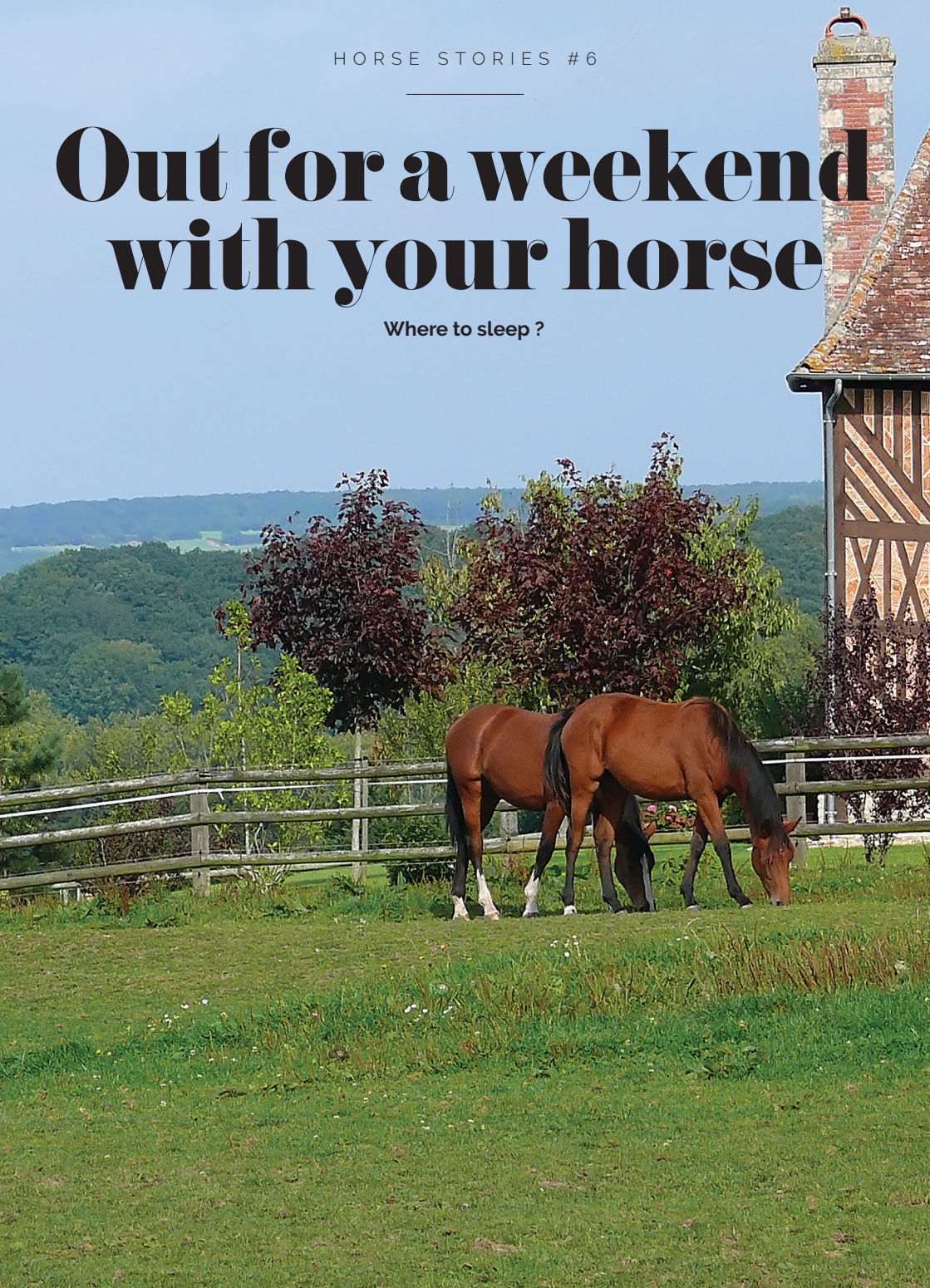

# Horse auction sales

## CO-OWNING A HORSE

Co-ownership formulas known as "écuries de groupe" (literally "group stables") emerged recently. It's an extraordinary experience! These formulas are available at various prices depending on your budget: for example, starting from € 50/year for the Écuries Club RMC, with over 15,000 members in 5 years. ARQANA – organizer of the famous sales of Deauville – also created his own program of "écuries de groupe" in 2013, known as ARQANA Racing Club. At a cost ranging from € 10,000 to € 20,000, 20 to 40 people can become the co-owners of 4 thoroughbred horses whose care expenses are covered for two years. They have access to stud farms, professionals and the sale backstage.



## THREE EXTRAORDINARY HORSES



### Urban Sea, « The Matron »

Introduced by the Haras d'Etreham at the August Yearling Sale in 1990 -when she was bought for F 280,000 by coach Jean Lesbordes for Hong Kong owner David Tsui -, Urban Sea participated in the most prestigious race in the world when she was 3: the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe. Later on, she gave birth to two champions: Galileo and Sea The Stars, who are race leaders.



### Almanzor, « The Champion of his generation »

Introduced by the same stud farm a few years later, in August 2014, Almanzor was auctioned for € 100,000 to coach Jean-Claude Rouget. After a skyrocketing success at the highest-level competitions in France, England and Ireland, and winning over 1 million Euros, he was nominated "Best 3-year male in Europe" in 2016. After this brilliant career, he returned to his native farm as a stallion. His first offspring were born in 2019.



### Pakistan Star, « The horse who wanted to be different »

Auctioned for € 180,000 at the ARQANA ring in August 2014, Pakistan Star was brought to Hong Kong. With his particular running style, he became a real local celebrity. With a slow start but an unequalled final spurt, he is known by many fans for overtaking his adversaries in the very last meter. A cuddly toy representing the horse was also produced.

# Thrilling for the races at the racecourse of Deauville La Touques

It's often said that the Morny Duke, actively participating in the Deauville foundation in the mid-nineteenth century, built the racecourse before the church.

This decision was taken because, at the time, the racecourse acted as a stadium and a casino. Moreover, a holiday resort without horse races was unimaginable. Picturesque buildings, the Anglo-Norman style of weighing scales, seagulls make you go back in time. Every year since more than 150 years, the racecourse offers a high-level program including at least 7 group 1 races (the highest race level). The best horses are there, together with the best jockeys, the best coaches, and horse owners, coming to attend the famous yearling sales.

The racecourse is also open in autumn and winter, since an "all-weather" fibresand track was added.

In total, about forty flat race days are scheduled every year. What about flat? It's the discipline that best express the speed of thoroughbred horses.

The racecourse also hosts AFASEC (Association de Formation et d'Action Sociale des Ecuries de Courses) since 1988, a school of horse races where the best professional jockeys are trained.

## VISITING THE TRAINING CENTRE

**Becoming a champion is all about practice!**

Every morning, horses come with their coaches, real mentors, to train for the competitions organized at the racecourse.

About twenty of them decided to stay in one of the stud farms stretching along the training centre of Deauville, hosting over 400 horses all the year round and up to 700 in summer!

Go along the Deauville-La Touques racecourse, at the heart of Deauville, passing through Avenue Hocquart de Turtot or Rue Letellier to see the stables of the training centre. In the morning from Boulevard Mauger, you may also see horses training on the racecourse tracks. From here, they have direct access to the beach - something unique in France -, where they can relax after training.

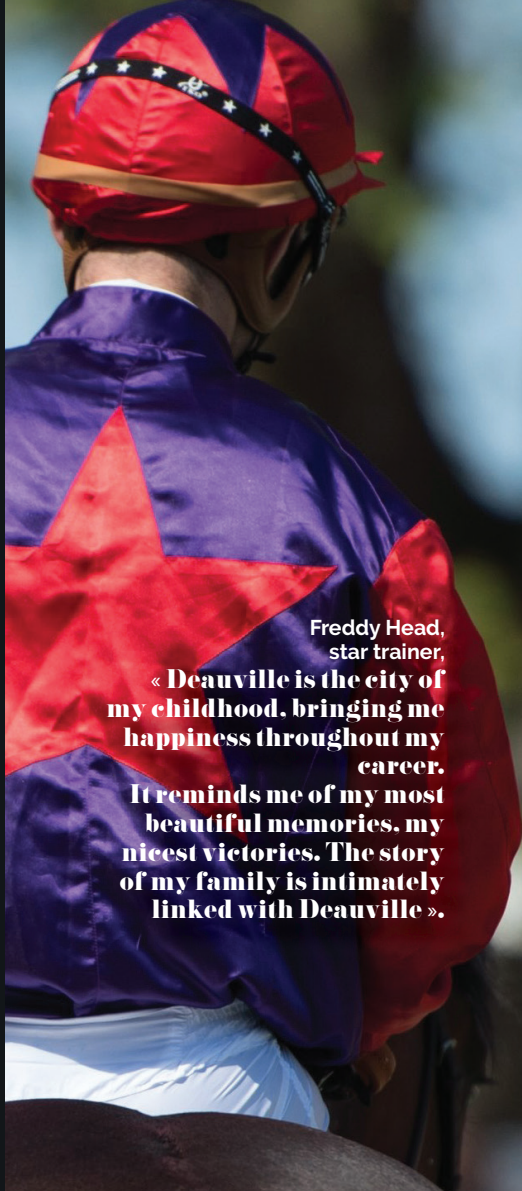

## **M**AJOR DATES OF DEAUVILLE LA TOUQUES RACECOURSE

### **End of July**

Attend the Prix Rothschild, an amazing straight-line race!

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This Group 1 race, the highest level of the competition, is reserved to mares aged 3 and over. It is a 1600-m race known as Mile, with emphasis on speed. It's a spectacular race for the public as the pack runs at more than 60 km/h on the curb, a few centimetres away from the public!

### **In early August**

LARC Prix Maurice de Gheest, a rare challenge between sprinters and milers

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It's one of the most awaited races of the Meeting de Deauville Lucien Barrière, as it is one of the few European races on 1,300 m: a middle distance. This original straight-line race is a good opportunity for sprinters - specialized in a distance ranging between 1,000 to 1,200 m - and milers - whose favourite distance is 1,600 m - to have an interesting and rare challenge.

### **Around August 10th**

Arab thoroughbred horses are on track for the Al Rayyan Cup Prix Kesberoy & Doha Cup Prix Manganate

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Two Group 1 races feature the Arab thoroughbred horses. The former is open to 3-year-old horses and the latter to horses aged 4 and over, that is to say confirmed horses. Arab thoroughbred horses are the ancestors of the most acclaimed horses in gallop races: English thoroughbred horses. In the 18th century, Eastern stallions were crossed with English brood mares, giving birth to English thoroughbred horses, known for being fast.

### **Mid-August**

## The remarkable Prix du Haras de Fresnay- Le-Buffard – Jacques Le Marois and its record prize

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It's also a 1,600-m straight line race and the highest-awarded competition of the Deauville Barrière Meeting. About 1 million Euros is shared among the 5 best competitors. The race is open to male and female horses from the age of 3. It may challenge young hopes and confirmed older horses. Champions come from all over Europe - sometimes even farther away - for this race. It's one of the most spectacular races of the Meeting!

### **Around August 20th**

## The Darley Prix Morny is given to the best young sprinter

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This straight-line race takes place on a short distance of 1,200 m. Competitors reach the finish line at over 60 km/h. The young champions have less than one minute to make a difference!

### **The last weekend of August**

## The Lucien Barrière Grand Prix de Deauville, a competition leading to another one

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This race labelled Group 2 is reserved to English thoroughbred horses aged 3 and over. It is a 2,500-m race: the competitors must show speed and resistance. The winner often decides to participate in the Qatar Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe, the greatest race in the world organized in October at the Paris Longchamp racecourse.

Half-timbered walls, roof niches, flowers: Clairefontaine is a friendly racecourse where races take place in a festive atmosphere. You'll find exhibitors and theme activities organized between stables and tracks. Every day is different here. Every race meeting has a different theme (charity, sport education days). Visitors love it; children enjoy!



## STEEPLE CHASE: A GREAT SHOW

Clairefontaine is the kingdom of children: games, free snacks, candyfloss and popcorns, make-up workshops, circuits of little cars, sulkies...

You'll find many and varied activities there. The event also includes days especially reserved to children like "Hippokids" of the Fédération Régionale des Courses de Basse-Normandie or "Courez aux Courses" of the Fédération Nationale des Courses Hippiques.

At the Hippogarderie, a free and supervised area, the racecourse also welcomes children in the afternoons of races. At the Hippik Kids village, children can find slides, swings, open-air games and giant table games like the Game of the Goose. Pony and horse-drawn carriage tours are also organized on race days.



### Feeling nature

About 100,000 flowers decorate the buildings. Tracks surround a reclaimed marsh, extraordinary flora and fauna natural reserve. At Clairefontaine, you are surrounded by nature.

The racecourse has been the first horse facility to reach the Excellence grade of the EquuRES label. This acknowledgement shows that the racecourse's managers are committed to the flagship principles of the label: energy saving, flow control, resources and biodiversity preservation, and finally, ground, water, air quality. In 2018, the racecourse drafted an ethical charter for visitors and operators!



# Trotting as a driver

Passionate for horse riding since they were children, Sarah and Edouard share a common love for sulky. In their renovated domain at the heart of nature, they gather old or unqualified harness racing horses to offer horseback strolls on the beach, tours on the track, initiations and intensive courses to teach people how to become independent drivers.

To ensure higher comfort, they created the first two-seat sulky in France using a Swedish model.

Before prospering with this activity launched in 2016, Sarah and Edouard spent their time between their passion for the Parisian activity of stone cutting and that of horse riding. During a weekend on the Côte Fleurie, their friend, a harness racing coach, introduced them to traditional sulky on the beach of Deauville.

"I just loved it! I was there, sitting the best I could on the training sulky: it was a magic and intense moment!" Aware of the lack of a sulky school accessible to everybody in France, they decided to create the European Sulky Academy with two partners. In 2014, they acquired the former farm of Edouard's grandparents, a peaceful place in front of the sea, but it needed to be renovated. "We made everything: the stables, the enclosure,

the pool and the track. We wanted everyone to be able to try the sulky, regardless of their age or physical condition."
